MICHAEL JAMES CAMILLERI PLEADS GUILTY

A Melbourne man today pleaded guilty in Melbourne County Court to seven counts of theft and one count each of making and using false documents.

Michael James Camilleri, who also uses the name James Camilleri, was charged as a result of a joint investigation between the Australian Securities and Investments Commission and the Australian Federal Police.

The thefts, which ranged from \$150,000 to \$4,000 and totalled \$346,022, took place between December 1995 and April 1997 and involved six separate individuals and personal superannuation funds.

The plea date has been set for 13 December 1999 at the Melbourne County Court.
